**To create** a network of support for religious congregations working in this field and encouraging those congregations who would like to join this ministry.

**To develop** reflection processes on the phenomenon of migration and to explore the implications for formation and mission within religious congregations.

**To develop** a spirituality that allows us to be converted by the migrants, refugees, asylum seekers, displaced people.
